GOVERNORS CAN PROTECT IMMIGRANTS THROUGH THE PARDON POWER

Many immigrants live at risk of deportation due to a past criminal offense. An immigrant with legal status can be deported for an offense, even if it is decades old. The convictions that can get someone deported range from felonies to misdemeanors like shoplifting or simple drug possession.

For many immigrants facing deportation because of a past offense, a pardon is their only protection from exile and separation from their families.
